LESSON

In the story, the Ethiopian man might have been able to read the Hebrew better than we can read Pitjantjatjara or Greek, but he needed Philips explanation to help him understand it.

When we learn to read something for ourselves though, in the language we speak it can make it easier to understand.

As not so secret agents we need to be ready like Philip was to listen to what God tells us and help others to understand His word too.
