MAIN IDEA

A counsellor is someone who you can turn to for advice and for help with your problems. A counsellor is there for you. Jesus is our wonderful counsellor; he is there for us - Always. Jesus is God with us.

LESSON

Read Scripture reference

So in this story, Joseph needed counsel. He needed some advise! He didn't know what to do. He Loved Mary and was going to marry her but He wasn't sure if he should or not.

But - God was there for Him. God gave Joseph a dream and in the dream an Angel told Him that Mary's baby was special, that He would be **Immanuel - "God with us"!**

Joseph was nervous and afraid, but he accepted the angel's advice. He married Mary, and he became the earthly father to our own Wonderful Counsellor.

Jesus lives in the hearts of all believers through the Holy Spirit. Any time, day or night, if we need advice, we can pray. The Wonderful Counsellor will hear us and guide us to make the right choice.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCES

18 This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit.

19 Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.

20 But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

22 All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet:
23 "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

What you need to know:

Jesus is God with us. He is always there for us, and He truly is a Wonderful Counsellor. When your kids have questions or problems, pray with them. Ask the Wonderful Counsellor to share His wisdom.

Find a small box that has a lid that can open and decorate it or wrap it in Christmas wrapping paper.


