1. PASSAGES TO MEDITATE ON

The following passages were referred to in the sermon. They all deal with being prepared for the return of Jesus at a time that is unknown. As you read pay attention to this context.

- Isaiah 55:1-2
- Mark 8:22-26, 27-33
- Matthew 10:5-8

2. JOURNALING QUESTIONS

Take some time this week to prayerfully reflect on one (or more) of these questions:

- Take some time this week to prayerfully reflect on one (or more) of these questions:
- How do you use your "natural" resources (finances, time, skills, possessions, etc.) to participate with the work of God in the world?
- What resources do you need from Jesus to see transformation in the lives of those he has sent you too?
- Reflect on a situation where you experienced the soothing or refreshing work of God through someone else.

3. PRAYER THEME

This week pray about the task we have been invited into; the restoration and renewal (soothing or refreshing) of all things in Jesus name.

4. CREATIVE ACTIVITY

Grab a hot cup of tea or a cold glass of water and take the time it takes to drink them to reflect on the power of either the heat or cold.
